DISCIPLE FAST TRACK I

Becoming Disciples Through Bible Study

This class gives participants a thorough introduction to the Bible. It meets for 24 weeks, devoting 12 weeks each to the Old Testament and the New Testament. Participants read a manageable 3-5 chapters of the Bible daily in preparation for the weekly meetings, which last 75 minutes. Into the Word, Into the World

This class will immerse you in the books of Genesis, Exodus, Luke, and Acts. Each week you will encounter three spiritual disciplines. This class meets for a total of 24 weeks, studying Genesis– Exodus and Luke–Acts for 12 weeks each.
